Criteria:

- After Transition II: Admission to Student Teaching, candidates can register for and take the Praxis II Exams for the Transition V: Optional Licensure. The following exams are required to be successfully completed for Elementary Education K-6 licensure:
 - o Praxis II Exam: Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades K 6 (PLT: K-6) with a score of 160 or higher*
 - o Praxis II Content Exam for program of study
 - Elementary Education: Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment (5017) with a score of 153 or higher for applicable candidates*

Summary of Data Analysis:

Eight out of nine candidates have completed the Praxis II Exam PLT: K-6 (5622) with a mean score of 174.75, 14.75 points above the minimum score of 160 required to pass by the State of Kansas. The strongest score in comparison to the national average range was in sections, III. Assessment scoring at the top range of the national average range listed on the candidates' score reports. One candidate did not pass the exam the first time by one point. Eight out of nine candidates have taken the Elementary Education: CIA exam (5017) scoring an average of 17.88 points above the state's required score of 153 to pass the exam. Praxis did not provide the EPP access to the first 4 individual candidate score reports so limited data is available for subtest areas on the Elementary Education exam. The greatest strengths so far are in Reading and Language Arts with an average of 22. The most difficult section has been the Social Studies subtest, the EPP believes this is due to not having a consistent instructor in the Social Studies Methods course.

Changes based on data:

Obtaining consistent faculty for all methods courses, especially Social Studies. Changes were made to the math course and curriculum in general education to include Beginning and Intermediate Algebra, which should prepare content knowledge for general education math K-6.
