

### Dorms

Dorms are checked and randomly checked by security at curfew and throughout the night.

Dorms do have cameras placed at each of the doors going into the dorms.

Secure personal items, open banking account to keep cash, lock doors so suitemates don't experience losses.

# BC Community Life

## Security

### Campus Intruder

- If indoors, move away quickly from the danger by exiting at the nearest exit.
- If an exit is not possible, quickly lock doors or create a barricade with large items such as desks and cabinets.
- Turn-off lights, and stay hidden, exit building and move away from danger, turn cell-phone ringers off.
- Call 911 when it is safe to do so,
- Warn others of the danger when it is safe to do so by contacting Students Services.
- Wait until the all-clear signal goes out via the emergency text notification system.

Visiting hours: 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM with the exception of Binford House. Binford is open for visitors 1:00 PM to 5:30 PM.

# Emergency Plan

## Tornado Warning

- Women's housing exit building and proceed to library basement.
- Men will go to Coppock Hall basement.
- Jackson Hall residents exit to library basement.
- Gym and soccer field, go to the Phillips basement.

**\*Town siren will sound long steady warning signal.**

# Emergency Plan

## Fire

- Women's housing exit building and proceed to west side of Lemmons Hall
- Men's housing exit and assemble on north side of Lemmons and Coppock Halls.
- Binford House exit house and assemble in front of house on west lawn. Fourplex and go to the library basement.
- Call 911 for all fire emergencies.
